Tomorrow, January 24th, Brevard County Commissioners will hold a regular meeting at Viera beginning at 9 AM. Dissolution of the Brevard County Historical Commission is item I.4.....on the agenda..

Discussion of dissolving or altering advisory boards has been ongoing by the current Commission. The Historical Commission is different in that it serves the public and could certainly be advisory to Brevard Commissioners if they were interested.

The Historic Commission issues periodic and informative Indian River Journals, compiles and publishes a “Historic Brevard Landmark Guide” and maintains a most helpful archive of Brevard County information. This archive has been considered a “safe haven” for local folks to bequeath and donate material valuable for understanding Brevard County’s unique and diverse history. In addition, The Commission has contributed to and produced a three volume history of Brevard County which is for sale.
