## **THE POWER TO PRESERVE**

Examining Local Historic Designation in Melbourne

This presentation will examine the local historic designation process in the City of Melbourne. The audience will learn why local historic designation is beneficial, which properties are already locally designated, the benefits of designation and how the application process works.

As a Certified Local Government (CLG), Melbourne has the ability to designate historic properties at the local level, ensuring the greatest level of protection to historic resources. Melbourne is the only CLG in Brevard County. The Historic Preservation Board and Historic Preservation Code make locally designating properties possible. Ms. Delmonico will also discuss the Historic Preservation Board's accomplishments and goals for the future.
